#### The Melbourne Chamber Choir

In its distinguished 33 year history the Melbourne Chamber Choir has performed with the Melbourne and Sydney Symphony orchestras, Orchestra Victoria and the Melbourne Chamber Orchestra, the percussion ensemble Synergy and the Stonnington Symphony Orchestra.

It has shared concerts with the choirs of the Blessed Sacrament Basilica of Christchurch, NZ, with North Arizona University Choir and with the Corinthian Singers of Adelaide. It has been involved in the Adelaide and Castlemaine festivals, and provided the southern continent choral music for the *Opening Ceremony* of the Beijing Olympic Games.

The choir will perform *Bijoux: French choral music gems*, in the atmospheric surrounds of historic St Peter's Eastern Hill, with music from Rameau onwards, culminating in the beautiful *Stabat mater* of Poulenc. The six cantatas written by JS Bach for the Christmas season 1734–35 were each performed on a major feast day from Christmas Day to the 6th of January. Together they tell the story of the birth of Christ, making a richly beautiful *Christmas Oratorio*. A masterpiece not to be missed! The choir will also perform the *Monash Cantata* written by Dr David Kram, combined with community ensembles

The Melbourne Chamber Choir is pleased, for a third year, to share its choral music making with Dr David Kram. David comes to the choir with years of international conducting experience. He is also an educator, pianist, music arranger and composer, and a Senior Fellow of the University of Melbourne.

The choir has hosted several Voices of Women festivals and attended a similar one in Adelaide in 2006. It has two CDs – Virtuoso Women and My Song in the Night.


